The Governing Body at St Bartholomew's currently has a composition of 16 members and is made up of:

Parent Governors, these are as the name suggests made up of parents from the school elected by the parents.

Staff Governors are elected from the schools teaching/ support staff.

Local Authority (LA) Governors these are appointed by the LA that maintains the school.

Co-opted Governors these are appointed by the Governing Body to represent community interests and can be persons who live or work in the community that the school serves.

Foundation Governors are appointed by the diocese of the church that the school which originally founded the school, they have a particular responsibility for RE and Collective worship.

Governing Bodies are established by law as a corporate body and acts as a group, their main responsibility is to determine the aims and overall conduct of the school with a view to promoting high standards of educational achievement. The specific duties of the governing body include setting staffing levels, appointing teachers and staff, setting and agreeing the school budget, ensuring that a broad and balanced curriculum is delivered as well as monitoring health and safety.

The Governing Body has a strategic responsibility with the day to day running of the school being the responsibility of the Head Teacher/ Senior Management Team and Staff.

St Bartholomew's Governing Body has four sub committees; Staffing and Finance, Curriculum and Standards, Strategy and the Health, Safety, Safeguarding and Site Committee. The committees meet once a term except the Staffing and Finance committee which has six meetings in total across the Academic year. The Full Governing Body meets four times.
