



St Bartholomew's C of E Primary School



Rainbows is St Bartholomew's chosen charity for the Spring term. The School Council have met with Gary from Rainbows and planned a series of fun activities to take place during the term to raise as much money as possible. Some of the activities will spread over the term, others will take place during 'Rainbows Week'.

#### Whole term activities

##### **The Collection Box**

Each family will be given a collection box to take home to collect any loose change in. (Note: We have stressed to the children they need to check with parents that they are ok to put money into the box). Collection boxes will be given out on Thursday 17th January - **Return by Friday 12th April.**

##### **Return of the bins (Bertie Bettie Barry)**

To give another opportunity for more clothing, bric-a-brac etc to be collected, the bins will return for another week **(1st – 5th April)**

##### **Sponsored lap of the badger trail**

The children will be given a sponsor form to ask family and friends to sponsor them to run/walk laps around the Badger Trail. They will record the number of laps they do during the daily mile, break and lunch on **Wednesday 10th April**. After school – parents/siblings will be invited to join in and boost their child's score. As soon as you get your sponsorship form – please start collecting sponsors!

#### **RAINBOWS WEEK 8th April to 12th April**

Just before we break for Easter, we will have a week of activities as follows;

##### **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April - Good Deed Challenge**

During the Rainbows week, your children may offer to do a deed for an agreed fee! e.g. make a cup of tea, wash up, tidy their room, weed the garden, dog walk, car wash etc. Your child will be given a form if they want to take part.

##### **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April – Art Competition**

For a fee of £1 per family, children can enter the art competition to draw/paint/collage a picture of a Rainbow. All entries need to be handed in to Mrs French by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April (The School Council will judge the winner at lunchtime).

**Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> April** – For a small fee, there will be games on during break & lunch (Football shoot out, Guess the skittles in the jar, Basketball)

##### **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April – Rainbows Main Day**

During this day children will be invited to wear any clothes that are the colours of the rainbow for £1 per family. There will be a sponsored rainbow walk/run after school with families on the badger trail. We will also have a cake sale during break and after school (if any there are left!) Juice will also be on sale after school for those taking part in the walk/run.

##### **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April & Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April – Breakfast Club**

Children from the school council will have a collection bucket available during breakfast club on both days during Rainbows week. If you attend the club, any small change you have would be gratefully received!

##### **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> April – KS2 Quiz**

Please could you ensure that the collection boxes and any other money raised is handed in to school by **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April** (the last day of term). Gary (from Rainbows) will return to school on that last day of term to be presented with the money raised and share in celebrating the children's fundraising efforts.
