A gentle appeal - just to keep in mind that we are a NUT FREE school environment. Please consider in view of packed lunches, snacks and or gifts .




COMPLETE AS MANY LAPS AS YOU CAN!

RED ROUTE: 1 MILE PURPLE ROUTE: 2 MILES






