

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is **St Bartholomew's Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is **The governing body of St Bartholomew's Church of England Primary School**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a) two foundation governors
  - b) four parent governors
  - c) one Local Authority governor
  - d) one staff governor
  - e) one headteacher
  - f) five co-opted governors.
5. Total number of governors is fourteen.
6. The term of office for all categories of governor is four years.
7. Two foundation governors to be appointed by the Leicester Diocesan Board of Education.
8. The school is held in a religious trust.
9. The governing body of St Bartholomew's Church of England Primary School makes the following statement relating to the character and ethos of the school:

"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils."
10. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member and associate member of of the governing body (and the headteacher if not

a governor), any trustees, and to Leicester Diocesan Board of Education as the religious authority.
