Curriculum and Standards Committee Terms of reference

Membership

The committee shall consist of up to 7 Governors, of whom one is the head teacher or assistant head. The committee may co-opt up to two non-voting members and must make recommendations for these appointments to the governing body for approval.

The quorum is 3 members including the head teacher or assistant head.

The committee shall meet once a term and otherwise as necessary.

Responsibilities

1. To ensure that the school provides a broad and balanced curriculum, that promotes the spiritual, moral, social, cultural and physical development of all its pupils.
2. To advise the Governing Body on the school's statutory obligation re National Curriculum.
3. To provide information to the Governing Body on how the curriculum is taught, monitored, evaluated and resourced.
4. To review all curriculum policies as required (including homework policy), overseeing the Governing Bodies responsibilities within each policy, especially re statutory responsibilities e.g. Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), RE, Collective Worship: to make recommendations to the Governing Body.
5. To receive regular updates on the progress being made towards school improvement priorities and pupil progress targets and make recommendations for approval to the Governing Body.
6. To monitor implementation of termly and annual curriculum priorities.
7. To monitor that assessment procedures are in place and are effective.
8. To review information about school performance, including behaviour and complaints.
9. To ensure that the requirements for identified and specified groups of pupils e.g. SEND, vulnerable and Gifted and Talented are identified, met and comply with LA requirements.
